SRO25 :- In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of section 3 the Jammu and Kashmir Entry Tax on Goods Act, 2000 (Act No. IV of 2000), the Government hereby exempt from payment of entry tax, leviable under the said Act, 46 digital boards purchased from Microline India pvt. Ltd. Pune to be imported into the State by Delhi Public School, Srinagar for providing quality education to its students subject to condition that the Principal of Delhi Public School, Srinagar certifies that the digital boards so imported are exclusively meant for the aforesaid purpose and no tax benefit percolates to the supplier.
