NOTIFICATION

Jammu/Srinagar, the 17 February, 2025

S.O. 44 : In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (3) of section 43 of the Police Act 1983, the Government hereby makes the following amendment in the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960 which shall have effect notwithstanding anything inconsistent in the Jammu and Kashmir Police Rules, 1960; namely:

In rule 176, in sub-rule (1), for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted:
namely:-

"a) he/she holds a Bachelor's degree of recognized University; however, the qualification for Sub-Inspector (Telecommunication) shall be a Bachelor's Degree (4 years degree course) from a recognized University in any of the following streams, namely:

- i. Computer Science, or
- ii. Electronics, or
- iii. Tele communications, or
- iv. Information Technology, or
- v. Mechatronics, or
- vi. Computer Applications, or
- vii. Data Science


